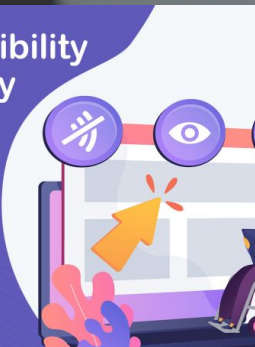

MAKING DSG ACCESSIBLE

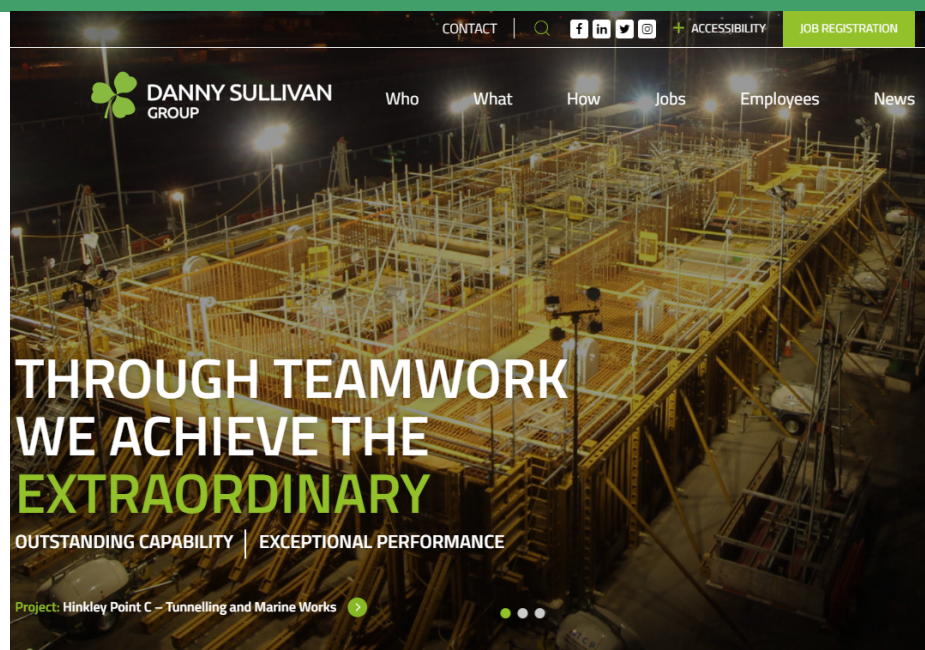

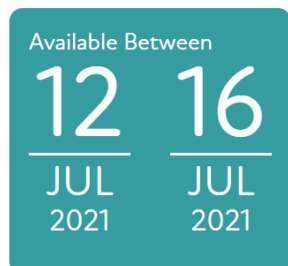
